# Ethiopian Eunuch

We read little about him, Ebed-  
Melech

**Jeremiah 38**

- **1) One man's faith can change the world**
- David, 1Sa. 17. 45: *"You come to me with a sword, with a spear, with a javelin. But I come to you in the name of the Lord of hosts."*
- The servant girl, 2Ki. 5. 3: *"If only my master were with the prophet who is in Samaria! For he would heal him of his leprosy."*
- The harlot Rahab, Joshua 2. 11: *"As soon as we heard these things (about God) our hearts melted, neither did there remain any more courage in anyone because of you, for the Lord your God, He is God of heaven above and on earth beneath*

## • 2) He knew right from wrong

- King Solomon, 1Kings 3. 9: *"Therefore give to Your servant an understanding heart to judge Your people, that I may discern between good and evil. For who is able to judge this great people of Yours?"*
- Mt. 12. 35: A good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth good things, and an evil man out of the evil treasure brings forth evil things.
- 1Sa. 12. 24: *"Only fear the LORD, and serve Him in truth with all your heart; for consider what great things He has done for you."*
- Ps. 37. 27: *Depart from evil, and do good; And dwell forevermore. .*

- He didn't just know right from wrong and say 'this is not of my business, I'm not going to have anything to do with this.'
- He didn't just go to the king because he knew the difference between right and wrong.
- He also took men with him, v11.
- He took old clothes and old rags and tied them together, v11.
- They let the ropes down into the dungeon, v11.
- The eunuch gave Jeremiah instructions, v12.
- And then they pulled him out of the dungeon, v13.

### **3) The eunuch had credibility.**

Col. 4. 5: Walk in wisdom to those who are outside, redeeming the time.

1Th. 4. 12: That you may walk properly toward those who are outside, and that you may lack nothing.
