 - It was a place of worship
 - It was where they offered prayers and sacrifices
 - Of its physical size
 - Of its looks, sounds, and aromas

GOD'S TEMPLE

THE PURPOSE OF THE TEMPLE

- God didn't actually dwell in the Temple
 - 1 Kings 8:27; Isaiah 66:1
- It wasn't for God's benefit
 - Acts 17:24~25
- It was a place of dedication and offerings
- It served as identifying them as God's people

YOU ARE GOD'S TEMPLE

- John 1:14 – “And the word became flesh and dwelt (tabernacled) among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.”
- Hebrews 2:14 – “Since therefore the children share in flesh and blood, he himself likewise partook of the same things...”
